Modern Slavery Statement

- 1.1 Hygiene Sue's core values are at the heart of everything we do. We are committed to running our business responsibly and in accordance with the high standards embedded in our core values.
- 1.2 'Respecting and valuing all individuals' and 'operating with honesty and integrity' are two of our core values. Slavery and human trafficking are plainly incompatible with these values.
- 1.3 We expect the same high standards from our suppliers and those we work with.
- 1.4 Our Procurement Policy helps us to consider issues around modern slavery and human trafficking with our suppliers
- 1.5 We will work with our principal suppliers to ensure that our approach to slavery and human trafficking is reflected in all our purchases of goods and services so that neither we nor they are involved in any way, either directly or indirectly, in slavery and human trafficking.

Our Commitment

- 2.1 We are committed to ensuring that slavery and human trafficking have no place in our business or our supply chain
- 2.2 This statement has been approved by the Senior Management Team and will be reviewed annually by senior Management.
- 2.3 This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our Hygiene Sue's slavery and human trafficking statement for the academic year ending 31st July 2019.
